The essence of the GEF supported SLEM-Country partnership program is to apply a multiland sectoral approach to management, related biodiversity conservation and climate change/ adaption issues in several states of India . In conformity with this programmatic approach the key objective of the project is to harmonize, coordinate and monitor interventions agricultural and natural resources management coordinate and monitor interventions in agricultural productivity while also enhancing positive environment impacts.

This is an umbrella project and will stakeholder include participation aimed at harmonising approaches already being tried and implemented in the 7 GEF projects throughout the country. In order to provide policy, strategic and operational guidance the on direction of sustainable land and ecosystem management within SLEM-CPP and with policy maker in India a National Steering committee with due representation of all key stakeholders is being set up under the chairpersonship of Secretary MoEF Addl Government of India.

The project will therefore : a) study the policy and programme guidelines of the concerned Minsitries/ Departments responsible for fortering SLEM b) identify the interventions / best practices that have potentials to be up scaled and mainstreamed / integrated into the said policies and programmes c) come up with an approach paper / document for advocacy and d) provide technical backstopping and inputs to the six projects participating in SLEM-CPP; Several institutes like ICAR,

ICFRE institutes, universities have standardized already documented a wealth of best practices that would help attain sustainable land management. Initially the project shall draw upon these learning .Subsequently as the learning start flowing from the six GEF supported SLEM projects these would be fed into the system and wherever required appropriate modification shall be recommended.

Issues for Directors

As mentioned above, there will be initially six GEF supported projects under the unbrella of SLEM-Partmership program spread over 15 states and Union Territories and focussing on area specific natural resources management issues. As such there is likely to be a significant overlap with the mandate of various institutes /centres of ICFRE. The list of these projects along with project area and names of concerned institutes / centres is enclosed at **Annex 1.** These institutes / centres will be assisting the project unit at the ICFRE headquarters in following

- 1. Creating a core team of experts drawn from different fields both from within and outside the institute for providing technical backstopping to the concerned SLEM projects
- 2. Visitings projects areas for identification of best practices as per agreed arrangement with concerned project authorities
- 3. Providing inputs to project unit at ICFRE headquarter on issues related to policy and institutional reforms.
- 4. Liasioning with concerned projects authorities to ensure timely collection of reports

In order to carry out these activities in a more effective manner each institute is required to nominate one officer/scientist of adequate seniority and experience I the related field as nodal officer – SLEM at the earliest.
