A Scientist–student connect initiative was envisioned and accordingly Indian Council of Forestry research and Education entered into MoUs with Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) and Navodaya Vidyalaya (NVS) in 2018. The concept was implemented in the form of a programme named “Prakriti”. Through prakriti programme Forest Research Centre for Ecorehabilitation (FRCER) at Prayagraj is working together to create awareness in the young citizens of our country towards building a greener India.

On 7th February 2020 a program was organized at KV cantt Kanpur where 10 KVs from Kanpur participated AND more than 150 children attended the programme. Representative teachers from each schools also attended the program. Venue Principal Sh. Som Pal, vice principal shift 1- Mr. Amod Kumar and Vice Principal- shift 2, Mr. Anchal Saxena welcomed the officers of FRCER with flowers and formal initiation of program started with lightening of lamp.



Welcome address was delivered by Principal, Kanpur Cantt. Sh. Som Pal. He welcomed officers and told students that as an intelligent students, should we not find ways to live and grow happily on earth and also help other creatures to enjoy the home shared by all of us. The Prakriti programme at the Centre is Coordinated by Dr. Anita Tomar, Scientist E & Officer-in-charge, Education & Training who informed that in 2019 twelve prakriti programmes were organized for KV cantt Varanasi, KV, Basti, KV, Shaktinagar , KV Amhat Sultanpur, KV Chopan, KV Bijpur Rihand Nagar, KV Gorakhpur, KV Azamgarh , KV Balia and from Prayagraj - KV Chheoki, KV IIFCO, Phoolpur, KV CRPF, Phaphamau. The students were sensitized about the benefits /contribution of forest for society and environment. She also informed that under this programme scientist of the Centre visit school or School children visit the Centre situated at Prayagraj.

Dr. Anita Tomar gave a brief introductory talk about the prakriti program followed by her presentation covering different topics viz. biodiversity conservation, endangered plants & animals & “Green Goods Deeds”. She requested students to start taking up at least one green good deed a day at the individual level so that there will be a billion green good deeds performed daily. Various films on environment awareness, plastic pollution, save water, save electricity etc was telecast for students.

Dr. Anubha Srivastava, Scientists-C gave brief introduction about the forests and forest cover of India with special reference to Uttar Pradesh. She also focus on agroforestry and trees suitable in agroforestry.

At the end of the program Quiz competition was organized by Dr. S. D. Shukla, Technical officer and Ms. Charlie Mishra, Junior Research Assistant (JRA). Prizes were distributed to the winners. Children actively participated in quiz and shows full enthusiasm. At the end Scientists replied to the questions/queries raised by students on various forestry related issues. Venue Principal, Kanpur cantt Shri. Som Pal presented a symbol of appreciation- a mementos to FRCER and to all the officers. Vote of thanks was given by Mr. Anchal Saxena. Compeering was done by Mrs. Geeta Bhadauriya, PGT Biology. The program was well organized by Kanpur cantt and proved beneficial to students. At the end of program students were confident and showed passion for protection of environment and forests.
