The consulting services ("the Services") include Evaluation of the Working/ Effectiveness of Forestry Extension System through the Van Vigyan Kendras and Recommendations for its Strengthening. Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE) has rich records of innovative developed technologies/processes to its credit and endeavors to transfer and disseminate the developed technologies through its Directorate of Extension. This Directorate has developed a variety of extension programmes to disseminate the outcomes of research to various stakeholders/ end-users with active participation of State Forest Departments and other institutions like Joint Forest Management Committees, Village *Panchayats* including farmers, women, industries and unemployed youth etc. ICFRE had initiated establishment of Van Vigyan Kendras (VVKs) in every state and Union Territory with active collaboration of State Forest Departments.

The consultant/consulting firm would look into the current status of Van Vigyan Kendras (VVKs), to develop a means for improving the working of VVKs and provide specific strategies/ guidelines/ plans/ recommendations for strengthening the existing VVKs and developing effective networking of VVKs with KVKs (Krishi Vigyan Kendras) etc. Terms of Reference for Evaluation of the Working/ Effectiveness of Forestry Extension System through the Van Vigyan Kendras and Recommendations for its Strengthening is given in Annexure - I.

- 4. Annual turnover of consultant during last three financial years should be Rs. 2 Million and above.
- 5. The consultant must have handled at least one assignment of Rs. 1 Million and above in the last three financial years
- 6. Qualification and experience of the key professionals
- 7. Proposed methodology and work plan for execution and completion of the assignment

TERMS OF REFERENCE (TOR)

Evaluation of the Working/ Effectiveness of Forestry Extension System through the Van Vigyan Kendras and Recommendations for its Strengthening

1. BACKGROUND

Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE) along with its nine research institutes (located at Dehradun, Shimla, Ranchi, Jorhat, Jabalpur, Jodhpur, Bengaluru, Coimbatore and Hyderabad) and five research centres (located at Allahabad, Chhindwara, Aizawl, Agartala and Visakhapatnam) are striving for the holistic development of forestry research through need based planning, promoting, conducting and coordinating research, education and extension covering all aspects of forestry. As a result of years of research work in forestry, ICFRE has a rich record of innovative developed technologies/processes to its credit and endeavors to transfer and disseminate the developed technologies through its Directorate of Extension. This Directorate has developed a variety of extension programmes to disseminate the outcomes of research to various stakeholders/ end-users with active participation of State Forest Departments and other institutions like Joint Forest Management Committees, Village Panchayats including farmers, women, industries and unemployed youth etc. ICFRE had initiated establishment of Van Vigyan Kendras (VVKs) in every state and Union Territory with active collaboration of State Forest Departments since the financial year 2007-08 for dissemination of various technologies developed by the ICFRE's institutes and State Forest Departments to the various stakeholders. ICFRE institutes have taken leading role in establishment of 29 VVKs in different parts of the country. The role and responsibilities of ICFRE for smooth working of VVKs are as under:

- Literature in the form of brochures, pamphlets, newsletters etc. on various aspects of forestry covering nursery techniques, management practices for insect pests and diseases, medicinal plant species, technologies and products developed by ICFRE institutes.
- Training/ capacity building covering nursery techniques, plantation techniques of forestry tree species, bamboo species, cultivation of medicinal plants, skill development on bamboo artefacts, vermi-compost, management of insect pests and diseases etc.
- Establishment and maintenance of model nursery for demonstration of nursery practices and supply of quality seedlings for plantation to the farmers etc.
- Equipment for training, demonstration (purchase and maintenance), engaging personnel for VVK related tasks, other overhead expenses etc.

The role and responsibilities of SFDs for smooth working of VVKs are as follow:

- Appointment of Nodal Officers and close coordination with concerned ICFRE institute.
- Providing and sharing of relevant literature.
- Infrastructure including building and fixtures
- Land for model nursery and trials
- Electricity and water supply

2. A PRECISE STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES:

To evaluate working/ effectiveness of Van Vigyan Kendras established in different states in fulfilling the objectives of forestry extension services to enable technologies from Lab to Land and make practicable suggestions to improve upon the working and effectiveness of VVKs in future.

3. AN OUTLINE OF THE TASKS TO BE CARRIED OUT (SCOPE OF THE SERVICES):

The main objective of the assignment is to develop a means for improving the working of VVKs with detailed strategies/action plans/guidelines. The consultants would look into the current status of VVKs and how these can be strengthened. The detailed guiding document would provide specific strategies/ guidelines/ plans/ recommendations for strengthening the existing VVKs, covering the funding, staffing, mode of functioning and developing effective networking of VVKs with KVKs (Krishi Vigyan Kendras) etc.

Following tasks are to be carried out:

- 1. Evaluate the current status of existing VVKs in at least 6 states (to be finalized in consultation with ICFRE); the evaluation should cover objectives, role, significance challenge and impact of VVK.
- 2. Assess the suitability of the current institutional structure and set up of the VVKs including their budgeting, political and institutional ownership, such as, the level of integration of VVKs with FDAs and State Forest Department.
- 3. Consult a wide range of experts and other stakeholders on the purpose, objectives and functionality of the VVKs. Stakeholders should include officials of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC), State Forest Departments, Forest Secretaries, Private Sector, Forest based MSMEs, NGOs etc.
- 4. Based on the findings of the evaluation propose recommendations for reforming the objectives, roles, institutional, financial and technical requirements, institutional set up and tie-ups for strengthening the VVKs.

4. SCHEDULE FOR COMPLETION OF TASKS: The implementation period of the assignment shall be three months from the date of award of the contract.

5. DATA, SERVICES AND FACILITIES TO BE PROVIDED BY THE CLIENT: Relevant documents /information required for conducting a study for strengthening the existing VVKs.
