A Report on Seminar by Dr. R. G. Venu, MBBS, Hyderabad held on 31th May, 2021.

Venu, MBBS, IFB Hyderabad. A total of 15 members of officials from IFB participated in the seminar.

The seminar started with a brief introduction to the topic of Corona and its current scenario. Dr. R. G. Venu, MBBS also explained the various possible symptoms of the disease, preventive measures, hygiene, and the habits to adopt in order to avoid getting infected.

He discussed in detail the different precautions like using masks, maintaining social distance, regular washing/ sanitizing the hands, and any consumable item(s).

He mentioned the symptomatic treatment if required and approaching the doctor/Hospital in case of any signs of severe symptoms or emergency.

He spoke about the importance of vaccines for COVID – 19 and relevant things to remember even after getting vaccinated.

He also spoke about the post COVID symptoms, Black fungus and preventive measures.
