## Ten days Bamboo Handicrafts Utility Products Training

ICFRE-Livelihood Extension Centre, Agartala (Tripura), a Unit under ICFRE-Rain Forest Research Institute, Jorhat (Assam) organized a ten-day 'Bamboo Handicrafts Utility and Products Training' at Kamalasagar, Sepahijala District of Tripura w.e.f. 12.03.2026 to 21.03.2026. The Training is organized under CAMPA-Extension of the Institute and attended by 24 (twenty-four) participants. The Training was conducted by Shri Atanu Saha, DCF, ICFRE-LEC Agartala.

Hon'ble MLA, Smt. Antara Sarkar Deb of Kamalasagar Constituency inaugurated the Training Programme on 12 March, 2026. In her inaugural speech, Mrs. Deb stressed on acquiring technical skills of making quality bamboo products which have high demand in the market. She also interacted with the participants. The Program was attended by Sri Kishore Kumar Roy, Pradhan of Madhupur Gram Panchayat. During the training program, basic techniques of wide range of bamboo handicraft items such as Pen Stand, Bamboo Lamp, Mobile Stand, Bamboo tray, Mat, basket, Mirror Stand, Flower Stand etc. making techniques had been taught. Seven Master Trainers from Agartala and Charilam have imparted the training as Resource Persons. The training program has been facilitated by the Ex NIT Agartala-student Shri Subhajit Chaudhuri for product design.







**Fig:** Bamboo Treatment by using salt in boiling water for handicraft items.

The trainees learned to operate machine cutter and bamboo treatment by common salt boiling and naphthalene as a low cost and easy method.
