The Technical evaluation committee appointed by IWST will carry out its evaluation applying the

evaluation criteria and point system.

The technical evaluation criteria will include the firm's relevant experience, technical manpower

The technical evaluation also includes examination of the quality of samples/reports of past jobs

Stage - 2 EVALUATION OF FINANCIAL PROPOSAL

The evaluation committee will determine if the financial proposals are complete and without

computational errors. The lowest financial proposals (FM) (The currency is in Indian Rupees) will be

given a financial score (SF) of 100 points. The financial scores of other proposals will be computed

as follows:

8. SCOPE OF WORK:

All data to be used has to be procured by the service provider however the parent organization would provide the projection parameters for Lambert Conformal Conic projection with Spheroid and datum as WGS84 for re-projecting all layers into LCC projection to the successful bidder. Geo-rectification of received/procured datasets would be the responsibility of the successful bidder.
- iii. Map composition has to be done for the riverscape.
- iv. For preparation of reports and presentation thereof the Technical Service Provider shall provide clear description of methodology to be adopted and they should imbibe GIS Compatibility of information/attribute data in all the phases and stages of the subject of his assignment.

- a) If any part of the contract does not correspond or agree with any other part, or if any question arises as to the meaning of the terms of the contract or as to the performance of the work, the Director, Institute of Wood Science and Technology, Bengaluru shall determine the matter and his/her decision shall be final and binding upon the parties hereto.
- b) The contract when executed by the parties hereto shall constitute the entire contract between the parties in connection with the works covered, and shall be binding upon the parties hereto or upon either of them unless the said modification shall be inwriting and duly executed by IWST and the firm.
- c) The contract shall not be assigned or sublet in whole or in part by the firm without prior written consent of the Director, Institute of Wood Science and Technology, Bengaluru. Any assignment or subletting of this contract by the firm without prior written consent of the Director, Institute of Wood Science and Technology, Bengaluru or any interest therein, or of an money due or to become due by reason of the terms hereof, shall be null and void.
- d) The Director, Institute of Wood Science and Technology, Bengaluru has the powers to cancel the contract at one-week notice, if the services of the contractor are found unsatisfactory or otherwise.

12.TAXES & DUTIES

- a) The prices shall be inclusive of all taxes & levies including GST and other statutory duties as applicable. Rate of taxes should be indicated separately in the Price Bid.
- b) Statutory deduction, wherever applicable, shall be made from invoice as per government rules. Necessary certificate will be issued for such deductions.
- c) GST component of the invoice of the bidder may be kept on hold in case there is any mismatch/irregularity in GST return filling on the part of the bidder.

13. PENALTY

In the event of failure to meet the job completion in stipulated date/time liquidated damage may be imposed on the contractor for sum not less than 0.5% of the contract value for that item/job for each week or part thereof.

14. TERMS OF PAYMENT

- a. 30% payment will be made to the Technical Service Provider on signing of the contract.
- b. 30% payment will be made to the Technical Service Provider on Submission of Draft report and map.
- c. 40% Final payment will be made on submission and acceptance of work along with Final Report by the department.

15.ARBITRATION

In the event of any dispute arising out of or relating to this tender, it should be referred to sole arbitration of the Director, Institute of Wood Science and Technology, Bengaluru or any other person nominated by him whose decision will be final and binding for both the parties.
