### **Terms of Reference for Engagement**

The Centre of Excellence on Sustainable Land Management (CoE-SLM) established at the Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE), Dehradun aims to develop scientific approach for addressing land degradation, coordinate with national and international institutions, promote South-South Cooperation, to share knowledge and capacity building to upscale and implement the Sustainable Land Management practices for achieving Land Degradation Neutrality.

#### **Outline of the Tasks to be carried out**

- 1. As per the UNCCD requirements, develop necessary data inventory of progress indicators related to desertification, land degradation and drought (DLDD), and sustainable land management (SLM).
- 2. Coordinate with organizations (viz., NRSC, SAC, FSI, IIRS, IMD, ICAR, and CSIR institutes, or any other institutes/departments) working on land resource assessment, combating land degradation, desertification and drought, climate change related studies, land degradation and biodiversity loss, meteorological observations, etc. for the collection and compilation of various geospatial data and non-spatial data related to DLDD and to fulfill the needs of the COE-SLM.
- 3. Facilitate in compilation of information and preparation of national reports pertaining to UNCCD.
- 4. Review and prepare reports on national and state level Policies, Laws, Regulations, Acts Land-use Plans, and Monitoring Systems at National and State levels, and align them with international goals to help achieve Land Degradation Neutrality through better land management, conservation of biodiversity, and action on climate change.
- 5. Support in preparation of capacity development training modules based on training need assessment for the application of GIS&RS tools in land resource management, monitoring land degradation, drought and desertification, monitoring land productivity, soil organic carbon and developing other spatial layers appropriate to DLDD related themes as per UNCCD strategic target framework 2018-2030.
- 6. Support in development of training modules based on training need assessment on the verticals related to Sustainable Land Management, Drought Risk Management and Early Warning System, Gender mainstreaming, good governance of land tenure, land rights and sustainable land management, and other themes based on training nee assessment.
- 7. Update and strengthen the LDN knowledge platform, data systems, and GIS-based tools to improve monitoring, reporting, and analysis of land degradation and sustainable land

- management, and develop a plan to ensure their long-term sustainability in terms of funding, institutions, and skilled personnel
- 8. Prepare standard operating procedures, training manuals, knowledge products and documents related to SLM, LDN, RS-GIS etc. for capacity building of stakeholders at sub-national, national and international levels.
- 9. Assist in activities related to land degradation assessment and development of thematic maps related to DLDD and SLM at the national level.
- 10. Collate research and knowledge in assessing land degradation, technologies, tools, and methods of arresting land degradation, impact studies, and policy analysis.
- 11. Execute other activities and tasks related to the core expertise assigned from time to time for achieving the objectives of the Centre of Excellence on Sustainable land Management in a timely manner.
